RMQHA Outreach Program Circuit High Point Horse Award

The Rocky Mountain Quarter Horse Association has begun a new pilot award program for all of the show circuits which are part of the RMQHA Outreach Program in 2010. This award will be presented to the Registered American Quarter Horse that gains the most points at a specified show circuit during the 2010 show year. This award will be presented at that show circuit's year end awards presentations event. It is designed to recognize the top Quarter Horse being exhibited there and presentation of this award will not affect the results or eligibility for any RMQHA Outreach Program awards presented by The Rocky Mountain Quarter Horse Association in the overall Outreach Program. The following rules will apply:

- 1. Points will be accumulated for one horse and one rider. Should more than one rider exhibit the same horse points will accumulate for each rider, not total for the horse.
- 2. Each exhibitor in the program must be enrolled in the RMQHA Outreach Program.
- 3. Points will be based upon the rules as currently established for the RMQHA Outreach Program.
- 4. All exhibitors must compete in at least 3 of the events of that circuit to be eligible for a year end award.
- 5. All exhibitors must compete in at least 3 classes at each event to be eligible for the year end award. For "Pleasure shows" one of these events must be in the RMQHA Outreach Program "In-hand" division(halter and/or showmanship) if offered at the show.
- 6. All points accumulated at each show will count toward this special award.
- 7. Each exhibitor that wishes to compete for this circuit high point award must complete a Circuit Award Form for each circuit which must be submitted with their show results form per RMQHA Outreach Program reporting requirements.
