RMQHA SHOW CONDITIONS FOR YEAR END AWARDS

RMQHA Show Division Points System

1. Halter and performance classes will have one point for every horse shown in the class. Points will be awarded through ninth (9th) place.

Example – 12 horses shown

1 st place.....	12 points
2 nd place.....	11 points
3 rd place.....	10 points
4 th place.....	9 points
5 th place.....	8 points
6 th place.....	7 points
7 th place.....	6 points
8 th place.....	5 points
9 th place.....	4 points

In halter, the Grand Champion of each sex division will receive one more RMQHA point than any other horse in its sex division. If necessary, additional points will be added to those won by the Grand Champion in its class to give it this total. The Reserve Champion of each sex division will receive ½ more RMQHA point than any horse in its sex division except the Grand Champion. If necessary, additional points will be added to those won by the Reserve Champion in its class to give it this total.

Classes combined at approved shows shall count as point classes in each age category for the purpose of tabulating Year End Awards. Points earned by Select Amateurs competing in Amateur classes are considered "Select" points for calculation of year end award standings.

2. In order to qualify for a Year-End Award, a horse, or horse/rider in the case of amateur classes, must have shown to at least 6 judges in the class for which they are seeking an award.
3. In halter classes all points will remain in the sex division for which they were earned (i.e., stallion points earned will remain in the stallion category for year end point standings; if the horse is gelded during the year and then competes as a gelding, points earned from that point forward would be tabulated for gelding year-end awards).

4. Year-end awards will be awarded to current RMQHA members in good standing. In all Halter and Performance classes, both the owner and exhibitor must be members in good standing in order to earn points for year-end awards. Year-end award points will be counted from date of paid membership.
5. Points for year-end awards will be counted from classes held at RMQHA approved shows.
6. In the Open Division all points and year-end awards will be awarded to the last owner of the horse who is a current RMQHA member. Open Division points are transferable to another RMQHA member.
7. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined on the basis of the horse shown who placed the highest the most times in the class in question.

RMQHA Open High-Point & All-Around Award Conditions:

A high-point award will be given for the High Point Earning Halter Horse. The horse accumulating the most points including points earned for Grand and Reserve Championships will be named High-Point Halter Horse.

A high-point award will also be giving for the High Point Green Performance Horse. Points may be earned in all green performance classes, points earned in Halter classes will NOT count.

No reserve High Point awards will be given.

An All-Around and Reserve All-Around award will be given to high point Junior horse and Senior horse which have shown a minimum of ten (10) times in both halter and performance events. Horses do not have to place in a class for it to count.

RMQHA Amateur, Select and Novice Amateur All-Around Award Conditions

1. Points for amateur, select and novice amateur All-Around awards must be earned at RMQHA approved shows in amateur, select and novice amateur classes. All points must be accumulated by one horse/one rider.
2. Points must be earned in two or more categories as published in the current AQHA Handbook. Points may include halter points earned in the

Amateur Division, however, halter points are not necessary to win an All-Around Award.

3. An exhibitor must show at a minimum of ten (10) RMQHA approved shows to be eligible for All-Around Awards.
4. A Reserve All-Around award will be awarded in the amateur, select and novice amateur divisions to the horse and rider with the next highest number of points, provided that all requirements as stated above are met.
